#### 1.4 Club Treasurer

Since last meeting, the club has paid out affiliations to

- Southern Cross Country league £50.00

### 1.5 Membership Secretary

Up to October 2021 there were 136 members. This is more than last year but still down on previous years.

#### 1.6 Club Captains:

Ladies: Kirsty Aked reported:

It's not been the greatest return to the HRRL for the ladies team. 2 races in out of 10 and we have yet to have a full team making us joint bottom of A division 1.

However it is not all bad news. The first 2 races did not sell out which demonstrates that it was a slow start for a lot of the HRRL teams, with Overton and Lordshill not being the most popular races (you only have to look at how quickly Stubbington sold out!). I am confident that we will have a strong team both at Gosport and Victory 5 as our runners confidence and desire to compete builds again. Jenny Parks is also supporting me with rallying our girls in my absence.

My main aim for this season is to ensure that we remain in Division 1 and do not get relegated. This would be such a real shame after we did so well in the previous season and particularly given the strength of our runners.

Men: Gary Armstrong reported;

#### First HRRL Race - Overton 5 Mile

3 Men competed, which left us 1 short of a full team.

## Second HRRL Race - Lordshill 10k

6 Men competed, giving us 1 full team.

It's been a slow start to the HRRL season for the men, as we can usually pull at least 2 full teams.

The A team are currently 8th in A Division 1

The B team are currently joint bottom with 3 other clubs as we have not had a B team yet

The C team are currently joint bottom with 11 other clubs as we have not had a C team yet

The next race is Gosport Half Marathon, from what I can see 11 men have signed up so far, which should give us a full A and B team. This will be a big improvement from the first two races.

As there are only 10 HRRL races this year it is only 6 races to count for individuals league and 8 to count for teams. (Instead of the usual 12 races. 7 individual, 9 teams)

### 1.7 X-Country Representative.

Paul Welch reported;

As I'm sure most of you are aware, I am happy to announce that the 2021 – 22 XC season is on with one race already staged. Below are condensed minutes from the SCCL AGM.

## 2021 / 22 season provisional race schedule

We have had responses from four clubs who typically organise races, leaving the current provisional list of races as:

- i. Folly Farm / Kingsclere Estate- 10 October
- ii. The Bourne Woods 28 November
- iii. Lord Wandsworth College 2 January
- iv. Chawton House 16 or 23 January
- v. Alice Holt 6 or 13 February (three weeks after Chawton House all clubs are requested to supply volunteers for this event)

There will not be a QE race this season.

#### **Covid mitigation at races**

A number of measures, proposed by race organisers, were considered, and the following was agreed:

- No food / drink gatherings at the end of races
- Results being circulated only later in the day rather than after the race
- Guidance to be issued by clubs to remind participants:
  - Results collators to social distance rather than gather at the finish funnel
  - · Runners go to club area when finished
  - Marshals to encourage runners on to own area
  - Minimising time at start line.

#### **Affiliation fees**

Due to the increase in expenditure from the need to pay for portable toilet facilities, the affiliation fees have been increased to £50.

## Virtual Striders' League

Most runners agreed that all routes were "quite challenging" and this was reflected in the age graded scores which were somewhat lower than for a typical HRRL route over the same distance. Most participants enjoyed the routes including the scenery which was over new territory for several Striders. The most popular events were Routes 6 and 7, the second 10 k and half marathons. I really appreciated the constructive feedback from everyone all which has been noted and will be implemented in the design of routes if we ever decide to run a similar event in the future.

Out of the 20 Striders who took part in at least one of the runs, 14 completed at least half of the routes, 11 complete 6 or more runs while 5 completed all 8 routes despite only the best 6 being counted toward their final score! It was great to see so many joining in with the spirit of the competition.
