Men: Gary Armstrong reported;

15 Men competed, which gave us 3 full teams. We came in 10th as a team out of 38 clubs.

1.7 X-Country Representative.

Paul Welch reported;

We're now 3 races into the season (out of 6 maybe 7, but I'm not convinced that the PJC one will happen) and have made an excellent start, we have had good attendances which means we have been able to field full teams at all three races and are performing very well, we currently stand 3rd in the league out of 23 teams.

Our team race results have been very good, the lowest team position being 5th & our highest being 2nd at the first race at Folly Farm.

This early in the season we have had 24 different men represent the club and nine of those have raced in all three races. Out of the 24 men we have had seven different scorers, so looking strong for the remaining races.

For the ladies, we have seen 14 different runners represent the club, with Lisa Peckover & Clare Welch being the two ever presents.

Eight of the 14 ladies have scored for the team, we only had five ladies turn up for the most recent race at Lord Wandsworth, but this did clash with the local coastal races, I'm hopeful that we will have more attend for the next race at Chawton.

As I mentioned earlier, I'm not hopeful that there will be a race at QE again this season as there has been radio silence in the XC committee about this. Fortunately Fareham are hosting a race this season so we will get a minimum of six races, unlike last year when we only had five. Also, 11 members have participated all of the XC races so far and have started to earn themselves bonus points.

<u>6.0 A.O.B.</u>

6.1 – Website (Graham Clarke) - Perhaps not unsurprisingly, the task to remove the fake Denmead Striders website is proving to be quite tricky! Unfortunately, during the weeks up to Christmas, I have had very little time to devote to this task but have just picked it up again.

Minimal progress prior to the Christmas period has been as follows:

• As a first step I wrote to EA's Legal Department to ask for their advice regarding our legal rights concerning misuse of our brand name "Denmead Striders". To date this request has

been ignored. I shall resend shortly in case it simply became "lost in the ether". Hopefully this may produce a response even if to say they are unable to help!

- I wrote to Dynadot Abuse Department (the host provider of denmeadstriders.co.uk) requesting that the website be removed. Dynadot's reply was that they do not have the authority to do this but have referred me to a "Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (UDRP) set forth by ICANN": This document is full of legal jargon which I have yet to digest! Does anyone know a friendly lawyer who won't charge us the earth in fees?
- There are a number of other avenues which I will explore to get the content of the site removed but it is going to be time consuming. Has anyone else got any ideas?

6.2 – First Aid (Raised by Clare Welch) – Our first aid certificated are running out. They are not a requirement, but there is an online course coaches need to do before renewing their licence. Gary McCawley will speak to all coaches to see if they would prefer a practical course. **ACTION GM**
