1.8 Striders League.

STRIDERS' LEAGUE

With just four HRRL races remaining at Alton, Netley, Alresford and Lordshill, the Striders' League competition for 2022-23 is drawing to a close.

There was a superb participation in all six of the Southern Cross Country League races. 56 Striders competed in at least one race of whom 7 gained the maximum of 40 league points, 7 dropped just one race while 29 were awarded bonus points by completing at least 4 races. Of course, the award of such a high number of points by individuals reflects the well-deserved success of the Striders in winning the SCCL championship this year!!

As far as the HRRL races are concerned, 58 Striders have competed of whom, to date, 10 have earned bonus points by completing at least half of the races. In the three additional League races, Striders' participation was as follows:

London/Southampton - 13

Bramley - 1

Winchester - 1

The reason for the low numbers at Bramley and Winchester may be the relatively high entry fee for both races and the travelling distance in the case of Bramley. (The latter used to be a very popular event as good preparation for the London Marathon!). In view of the low popularity of these two events, we/I will need to review the additional (if any) races to include in next season's League programme. The original reason for including these additional events was to provide a bit more variety for members over and above the 12 HRRL races which vary very little from one season to the next. The Southampton Marathon/Half Marathon was chosen as an alternative for those members who were not able to secure a place in London and originally took place on the same day but even that idea seems to have "gone overboard" this year, Southampton occurring a fortnight before London.
