### 1. Committee Meeting.

#### 1.1 Club Chairman

As already mentioned between a few members it would be fitting to send a donation on behalf of the club which I will mention in AOB.

The new club kit is finally on order through Ronhill and will be put onto the same site as the hoodies for ordering. The club will make the initial outlay and then when items are sold, monies will be transferred back to the club at agreed intervals from Hambleside who run the shop.

## 1.4 Club Treasurer

Stuart Hoare reported;

Period since May 2025, the last meeting.

The club has received a steady flow of new members to the club, thirteen over the past three months, adding to the retained funds of the club.

Expenditure during the three months was payment of the Hampshire Road Race League entry for the 3 Ladies & 3 Men's teams, total cost of £150

The remaining subscription due will be the Southern Cross Country, prior year was £125

The club has reimbursed Oliver Craig for his Leadership in Running Fitness course and qualification, total cost of £160

Two of the training sessions have been held at Horndean Technical College, the cost of those evenings together was £120

Denmead 10k, we have seen monthly income starting to flow in, naturally these monies are allocated for the payment of the relevant costs, nearer to the event in October. Currently there is a net surplus held at £2,675 to set against estimated costs of around £3,000.

Excluding the funds held in advance for the Denmead 10k, the club has a total of £4,500

### 1.7 X-Country Representative.

### **2025 / 26 season provisional race schedule**

We had the AGM early July & heard from the clubs who organised races last season, the current provisional list of races are:

1. Benyons Inclosure - Sunday 2nd November
2. Bourne Woods – Sunday 23rd November
3. Lord Wandsworth College - date tbc (but probably between Christmas and New Year)
4. Chawton House - Sunday 18th January
5. Alice Holt – Sunday 1st March
6. Hundred Acre Woods - Sunday 8th March (may move to February because of the closeness to Alice Holt date)

### **EA requirements**

It was decided that the league would still allow non-affiliated runners to attend and that the £2 per race fee would remain, this is to allow them to be covered by the EA insurance.

The only change was that club reps had to bank transfer the fee to the relevant RD within 7 days after the race and no cash should be handled.

I don't believe this will affect us as we generally only have EA affiliated members.

### **SCCL finance update**

The League currently has funds of around £100, with the following projected income and expenditure expected to be the same as last year.

Therefore, it was decided to keep the affiliation fee the same as last year which is £125 per club.

### **AOB**

- It was discussed about expanding the league, but the vote decided that there will be no increase in numbers due to already high numbers of participants and that we would operate a one in one out policy only.

It is with a heavy heart that I will be stepping down from the Cross country rep role at the end of this season, I think that this will be my 9th season and feel it's time to let someone else take the reins. I am obviously happy to shadow someone for this season and complete my role at the AGM & awards evening. Many thanks to the entire committee past and present for their support throughout these years.

The final event of the Striders' League competition, Lordshill 10k, took place on the 6th July giving Striders the last opportunity to pick up valuable League points including bonuses. ### **Striders' League Races for Next Season**

Amazingly, it is now only just over two weeks until the start of the HRRL for the 2025-26 season! The first race will be the Totton 10k on Sunday, 31st August which will be a new race for most although some will remember it as part of the HRRL some years ago (well before I joined the club!).

### **HRRL and SCCL Fixtures**

The Striders' League fixtures for the next season will include all twelve HRRL races and all six of the SCCL races as usual. It should be noted that the Stubbington 10k is not part of the HRRL this year and the Solent Half will move from its usual autumn date to the spring 2026

### **Additional non-HRRL Road races**

After some deliberation, I thought that I would like to try adding two more races into the League again this year to add a bit more variety and cater for both those runners who like the challenge of longer distances – half marathon marathon-and those who prefer the shorter 10k. To this end I have selected two additional events on the basis of the following criteria:

1. Date not to clash with any of the SCCL or HRRL fixture
2. Reasonably local
3. Likely to be popular based on events attended by Striders in past couple of years.

The events are:

Stubbington 10k on 11th January 2026 - been in HRRL for many years

Southampton Marathon/Half Marathon 3rd May 2026 (runner to choose distance)

If everyone is happy with these proposals I will go ahead and set up the Striders' League score sheets on this basis.

The committee agreed to Grahams suggested races.

### **League rules for 2025-26**

Essentially unchanged from 2024-26 with only the best 10 of the road race results to count in assessment of final score.

As with the other committee members I am happy to continue in my role but equally happy to handover if anyone would like to have a go at the newsletter.

#### 6.0 Website

Graham Clarke reported;

Generally running OK although some problems have emerged in recent days which are under investigation e.g. links to email addresses are not working, the calendar function needs to be changed. Some updates are required e.g. some photographs are a bit dated and I believe that there is a requirement to make the site more "mobile friendly" ... I always welcome comments and suggestions and reporting of any problems with using the site!

As an aside, our old domain "denmeadstriders.co.uk" seems to be up for sale again for an initial nominal sum. I did wonder whether maybe we should purchase it to avoid the problems of a couple of years ago. However, there are still lots of other similar named domains e.g. denmead-striders.co.uk, denmeadstrider.co.uk, denmeadstriders.net etc. which anyone could purchase for mischievous purposes should they so desire!

The committee decided to leave the domain as is.

## 7.0 A.O.B.

### **7.1 London Marathon - Allocation of Club Place** – Raised by Steve Trevenna.

Constitution - as is and *proposed modification*

Procedure for allocating guaranteed London Marathon places with a verbal guaranteed entries for the London Marathon will be awarded to individual paid up club members who have been selected on the following basis:

- Must have been a paid up member for a minimum of the previous 3 consecutive years at the date of the draw.
- Formal entry for the relevant year's race must have been officially refused. Proof of rejection is required.

Selection will be made by drawing qualified members names from a hat

\*\*\*

- *Draw Pot 2:* Members must have never run the London Marathon in the past.

• The location and date for the draw will be communicated on at least two separate Wednesday evening training sessions

• In the event that more places are available than qualified members in a draw category, a further draw open to all paid up Club members will take place

Add at this location\*\*\*

*Members who have failed to gain a place via the club draw for a minimum of N years are put into Pot 1. If there are no such candidates Pot 2 shall be drawn. [I would propose that N should be 4 or 5 years]*

The committee discussed the above and it was decided to leave the allocation rule as it is now to not over complicate.

### **7.3 Charity Donation in memory of Gary Cassap** – Raised by Clare Welch
